This is just like a Granny Square, but in the round! No corners! We are making multiples of these for our Cozy Apple so it is important we use the same kind of yarn and same hook size but the color combos are up to you! I suggest using a minimum of 3 different shades of reds.

Supplies Needed:

*J Hook /6.00 mm

* Acrylic Yarn in shades of Reds

I recommend JoAnn's Fabrics Big Twist 6oz 100% Acrylic=

-Medium Rose (light pink)

-Hot Pink (bright pink)

-Varsity Red -(bright red)

- Wine (dark red)

- Deep Red (red)

You can use Red Heart Super Saver as well.

Notes You can crochet over your ends for each round or tie them in with yarn needles. Leave 6 inch tail on last round for sewing *Each Chain 2 counts as 1 dc in beginning rounds* Join with Slip stitch end of each round. Cut and add new color when you want.

Ch 4, Join with Slip stitch to form ring

Round 1: Ch 2, Counts as 1st dc, 11 dc inside ring (12dc)

Round 2: Ch 2, 2 dc in between each dc (24 dc)

Round 3: Ch 2, 3 dc in between each 2dc (36 dc)

Round 4: Ch 2, 4 dc in between each 3dc (48dc)

Round 5: Ch 2, 5 dc in between each 4dc (60 dc)

Round 6: Ch 2, 6 dc in between each 5dc (72dc) ***Cut tie off leaving 6 inch tail for sewing.***
